Managing Emergencies & Risk

The field school is focused on the role of local and Indigenous knowledge in risk management through the lenses of recreation and tourism. Students will have several opportunities to experience and learn about Maori culture and explore social justice issues related to leisure access.



Three Adventures for \$5,500*

The field school includes three different experiences:

- Nov 29-Dec 6 is a risk and emergency management-focused tour of the South Island. Visiting places like Christchurch, Queenstown, and Milford Sound.
- Dec 7 - 10 is the World Leisure Centres of Excellence Network field school in Dunedin. Focused on social justice and leisure access for marginalized populations.
- Dec 11-16 is the World Leisure Congress at the University of Otago. Students will attend and present at the first in-person meeting of the World Leisure community since 2018!

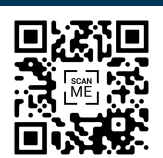
